The Guardian Scholar Mentor is a position to provide support, guidance and life-enriching experiences to former foster youth in order to help them achieve their full potential through a 1:1 mentoring relationship.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Commitment of one year to the program (minimum)
- Commit to approximately 10 hours per month consisting of:
  - 1 meeting with the assigned student in a 1:1 setting
  - Have weekly contact with your student via phone, email, text or Facebook
  - Attend group sponsored activities (minimum 2 annually)
  - Submit a monthly report to Guardian Scholars
- Participate in constructive, esteem-building activities with the student
- Support student in their educational goals
- Serve as a role model for youth transitioning from foster care to adulthood
- Commitment to promoting Promises2Kids mission and programs to ensure we are creating brighter futures for all foster youth ®.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must be 28 years of age or older
- Must successfully complete:
  - Orientation
  - Application
  - Interview
  - Background Clearance (LiveScan)
- Provide valid copy of drivers license and proof of insurance
- Provide printout of your driving records from the DMV
- Provide at least three references: No family members or friends
- Must show stability in personal life and work history
- Must be committed, reliable, responsible, flexible, patient and non-judgmental
